WELCOME TO SLOVENIA

Slovenia lies in the heart of Europe, where the Alps meet the Mediterranean and the Pannonian Plain meets the Karst. This small **green** country measures 20,273 km2 in area, and is home to sincere, **hospitable** people of great diligence. In this small piece of Europe, bountiful Nature has combined and interwoven a whole range of diverse landscapes. Mighty Alpine peaks with sheer faces, deep karst caves and potholes, softly rounded hills and vast plains: Slovenia has all of these. There are also beautiful lakes and bubbling brooks, the silence of forests and the crashing waves of the sea.

BLED

The charming town of Bled is fairly developed at one end with lots of bars, restaurants, hotels and other tourist facilities, whilst at the other end it is quieter and generally less built up. Taking a 'Pletna' boat out to the island is certainly one of the highlights of any trip to Slovenia, the island has 99 steps and a local tradition at weddings is for the husband to carry his new bride up these steps, during which the bride must remain silent! Lake Bohinj: less than half an hour's drive west from Bled is located in the Triglay National Park and has an altogether more remote and tranquil feel – the serene lake, surrounded by beautiful mountains and quiet villages is a superb place to rest and unwind and is bursting with opportunities for outdoor activities from walking, mountain biking and boating / swimming in the lake in summer to skiing in winter. Vintgar Gorge: one of the country's most impressive gorges with a very visitor friendly walkway taking you through it, is to be found a few kilometres north of Bled near the Village of Gorje. The medieval old town of Radovljica 10 km from Bled is one of the country's best preserved medieval towns and well worth a visit. Bled is also well known for its Vanilla & cream pastry!
